# Dress Code

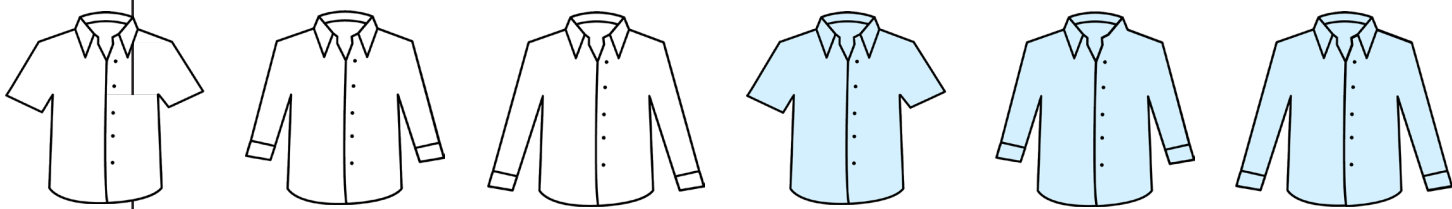

White, red, or black shirt with a collar (long-sleeve or short-sleeve polo or turtleneck)



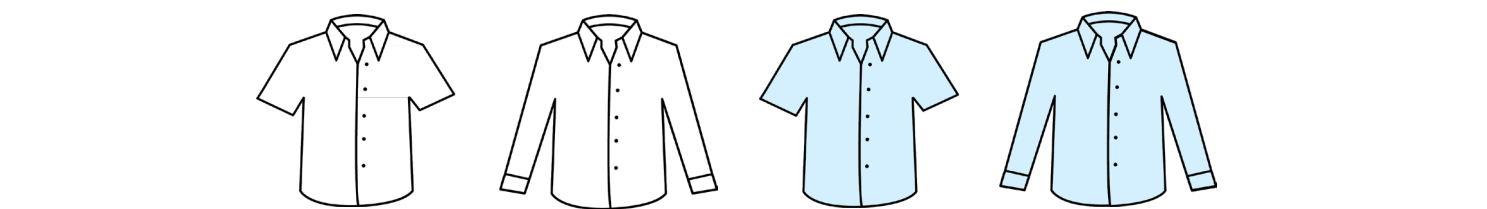
White or light blue dress shirt (long-sleeve, short-sleeve, or 3/4-sleeve)



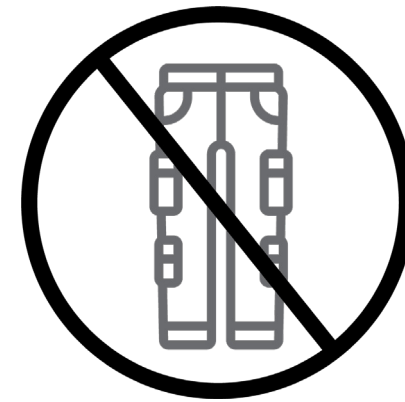
"Skinny-stretch pants" or "jeggings" are not acceptable

Solid white, red, or black sweater (v-neck or cardigan) free from all logos (except NCS logo)



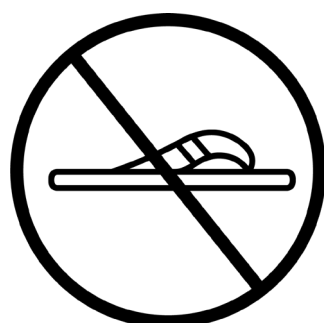
