Supplies students need on the first day of school:

Please **label** each item with your child's name.

- Fully charged, school-approved Chromebook
- Binders for classes
 - *Some students prefer to have three 2-inch binders and use them for two classes per binder, while other students prefer to have six 1-inch binders and use one binder per class; discuss with your student what organizational style will work best*
- 3 packs of dividers
- 5-6 packs of loose leaf paper
- 1 composition notebook
- Pencil pouch
 - *Students who struggle with organization may wish to have several pencil pouches that can clip into their binders*
- No. 2 pencils, several packs
- Black or blue pens
- 2 red pens
- Highlighters
- 3 packs of index cards, lined or unlined
- Paper planner (for writing down assignments)
- Texas Instruments 84 or 84 PLUS calculator (no alternatives)
- Earbuds or headphones (should be compatible with student's Chromebook, but do not need to be expensive)
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
- *Reconstructing America* by Joy Hakim (available on Amazon; may be new or used copy)
- *Age of Extremes* by Joy Hakim (available on Amazon; may be new or used copy)
- *War, Peace, and All that Jazz* by Joy Hakim (available on Amazon; may be new or used copy)

Students in Band:

- *Tradition of Excellence: Book 2*, available at Star City Music and other music stores
- Box of tissues, no lotion, to be dropped off in the band classroom

Students in Art:

- Bound 9x12 sketchbook, at least 100 pages

While not required, students may find it helpful to have the following:

- Colored pencils
- Markers
- Hole reinforcers for loose leaf paper
- A lanyard for keycard, with or without a protective badge holder

At home, students will need access to the following:

- Tape
- Stapler
- Glue
- Ruler with metric units (mm, cm)
